This Sunday, Art Smith-Windsor will be taking photos of new members for the photo board at St. John's. Please meet him in the parish hall after the service!

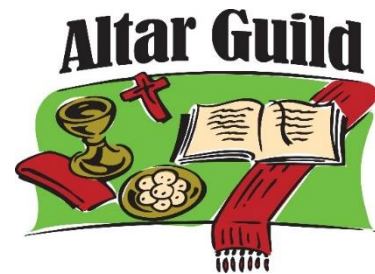


St. John's Reading Place
